NEW EXIT ONLY TIMES FOR 2024 - There will be an exit only for horse lorries and trailers to leave showground at 10.00 am for 15 mins and at 11.30 am for 30 mins. Then all others after the grand parade.

New 2024 recommendation from Association of Show and Agricutural Organisation

Suitable mounted - All animals ridden anywhere on the showground, rings or lorry parks (day or night), must be ridden by a rider whose size and weight does not compromise the animals welfare. We are operating under the 20% weight guideline where the rider in full riding attire with full tack must be less than 20% of the animals bodyweight. This is based on a relatively fit, healthy animal, as an overweight animal is also a welfare concern.

In the event of a fall of horse and/or rider the competitor should leave the ring immediately on foot

The Judge need not ride all horses forward.

Riding hats must comply with the current safety standard (refer to your Society/Association rule book) and be worn by riders at all times when mounted.

Grand Parade Raffle - Two prizes of £50 kindly sponsored by Bowen Son & Watson. All prize winners appearing in the Grand Parade are eligible.

Cups can only be collected from the secretary's office after the grand parade has finished. Exhibitors unable to collect cups after the Grand Parade can collect from the show office by prior arrangement after show day. No cups will be given out prior to the Grand Parade.

Payment of Prize Money – Horse Class Prizes will be sent by cheque within two weeks of the show.

Equine Influenza - All horses present at the show are required to be fully up todate with their Equine Influenza vaccinations. All horses starting a new course of vaccination after the 1st January 2024 must comply with the requirements of the primary course (1st vaccination and then 2nd vaccination between 21 –60 days later), followed by the first booster (120 – 180 days) and all subsequent boosters. Horses may compete having received the primary course and prior to the first booster but not within 7 days of receiving a vaccine dose. Horses must have been vaccinated within 12 months before the show but not less than 7 days of arriving at the show

Foals - In-foal mares that have already had vaccinations of primary Equine Influenza course should be vaccinated 4-6 weeks before the foal is due to be born. Foals should be vaccinated for Equine Influenza at 6 months to commence their primary course. Please consult your own veterinary practice for further information.

Passports will be checked at random during show day.
